Introduction

AS9100D Counterfeit Goods Definition:

An unauthorised copy, imitation, substitute, or modified part (e.g., material, part, component), which is knowingly misrepresented as a specified genuine part of an original or authorised manufacturer.

Objective

To preclude the introduction of counterfeit product into our supply chain through strict avoidance, mitigation, and disposition processes.

Midland Aerospace Ltd purchases material, goods, and equipment etc from authorized manufacturers and suppliers. Examples of a counterfeit part can include, but not limited to, the false identification of marking or labelling, grade, serial number, date, documentation, or performance characteristics.

Traceability of Product

Midland Aerospace Ltd maintains traceability of purchases from Authorized Suppliers, retaining the original purchase orders and other receiving documentation for the required document retention periods.


Return of Product

The disposition of any products returned by our customers will be identified. Any product that is deemed to be defective and not recoverable will be disposed of in accordance with the company procedure. We will only use authorised scrap metal merchants to ensure no defective product is returned to the supply chain.

All records are maintained for a minimum of 5 years including incoming paperwork and system product traceability.
