

Counterfeit Goods Policy Statement

Midland Aerospace Limited understand that counterfeiting is a serious issue and poses a significant safety hazard within our industry. Midland Aerospace do not use, nor condone the use of counterfeit and gray market products. Midland also expect our supply chain to adhere to our ethical business standards and mirror our practices and procedures.

Midland ensure that we have a stringent policy and procedure to ensure we do not have counterfeit (non-conforming) products entering our supplier chain. Midland will only purchase products from our approved suppliers such as: OEMs, manufacturers, franchised distributors or agents.

Midland will inspect all parts upon receipt and ensure that the part is compliant to manufactures specification. Any part that is deemed to be counterfeit will be documented and an investigation will be carried out by Midland and the supplier. Depending on the outcome of the investigation, the supplier may or may not be conditionally reinstated as an approved supplier of Midland Aerospace.

Once a part is confirmed to be a counterfeit part, company directors are notified. The is enforced by procedures and controls in place in compliance with the Aerospace industry standards and will be regularly reviewed and updated.
